
MISS MEDLINE EUGENE EFFET (ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER)

• The Organic component of Solid Waste may not be too much of a problem since that is biodegradable. 
• Plastics have replaced leaves, glass and metals as a cheaper and more efficient means of packaging this shows the demand for recycled plastic bottles.


Our Operations

We have a crushing and hot-washing plant in port Harcourt and we have partnered with different like minds to create collection centers around the







